Parenting programmes starting in September

Cygnnet: Parents and carers with children aged 5 to 18 who have been diagnosed with a condition on the autistic spectrum.

Who's in Charge: For parents and primary carers of children aged 8 to 18 who are abusive, violent or who appear out of parental control.

HENRY: Providing parents with children aged 0 to 5 years the skills, knowledge and confidence to give their children a healthy start in life.

Family Links Nurturing – supporting positive parenting and exploring the emotional needs behind behaviour. For parents/carers of 2-13 year olds.

DICE – a support programme for parents/carers to raise awareness of the risks of exploitation.

Talking Teens – positive parenting and relationship building for parents/carers of 11-18s. Covers understanding your teen, managing conflict, communicating and more.
